PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF REPORT:

PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to estimate the Fair Market Value of the custom vehicle described herein, at the time of the inspection on behalf of Woodside Credit. The purpose of the inspection and this report is purely to establish that the inspected vehicle was worth the amount financed. The inspection performed on this vehicle was NOT to establish the functionality or operation of any electrical, hydraulic or mechanical systems on this vehicle.

If mechanical or other diagnostic are required to be performed on this vehicle the customer requesting this report, or the buyer of the vehicle must consult and retain a qualified ASE Certified or other specified mechanic for that purpose.

FAIR MARKET VALUE

Although the *Classic Auto Appraiser* has an extensive library, we do not have direct access to specific manufacturer's records, log books, files, computer data bases or other non published information.


